Difficulty: Junior

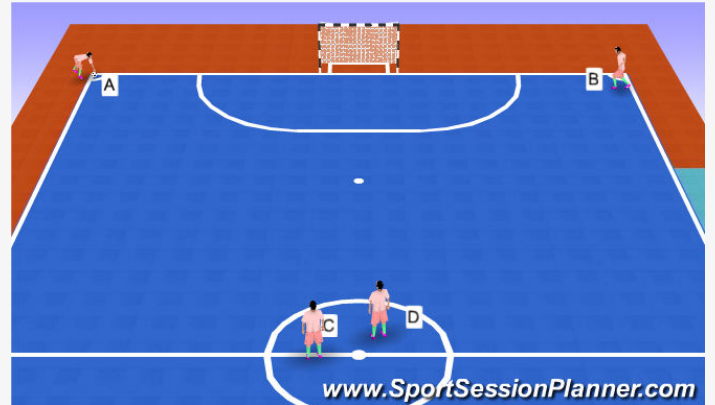

Starting Position

Kicker calls "BUNCHES!" to remind of starting formation.

A "defender" takes the opposite "B" position, and when everyone is in position calls "PIVOT!"

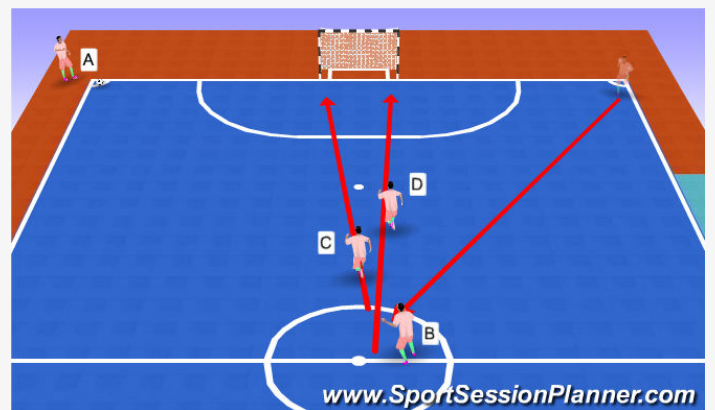
("Pivot" is a reminder to herself that she will hustle to the top center position as the defensive pivot)



Movement on Cue from Corner

After "B" defender calls "PIVOT!" the "Kicker" calls "READY!" which starts the motion.

"A" Kicker times her kick with her runners "C" and "D"



Action

"A" Kicker comes on to court to promote good triangle shape, prevent quick counterattack, and clean up any rebounds from goal.

"B" plays a critical role. She must hustle to the top to take the defensive position and stop any quick counter attack.
